CRITICAL RACE THEORY IN CALIFORNIA SCHOOLS


A GREAT BOARD RETREAT






A great board retreat at the beach, as we sat around the bonfire (and retreated indoors when it got too cold) to discuss our board priorities and focus for the new year.

With countless Southern California residents working and learning from home, now is the perfect time to explore helping to transform the life of an individual who is blind or visually impaired by raising a guide dog puppy with Guide Dogs of America.

Plus, puppy breath makes everything better – even living under the cloud of a pandemic!

"The need for highly trained guide dogs and service dogs hasn't slowed during the pandemic," said Stephanie Colman, puppy program coordinator with Guide Dogs of America. "In order to match service dogs with people who need them, we first need dedicated volunteers to help raise these amazing animals."

A puppy raiser's job is to provide a loving home, teach basic obedience, proper house manners, and provide ongoing urban socialization to help the puppies learn to be calm and confident in the many situations they will likely find themselves in when working as guide dogs. Often, many applicants are forced to table their interest in raising upon learning their employer would not allow the puppy-intraining to accompany them into the office, and when there wouldn't otherwise be anyone home to work with the puppy during the day. Due to COVID, many employers have embraced telework indefinitely, lifting a significant barrier to raising.

"In many cases, major companies have announced a permanent work-from-home option for employees," said Colman. "This has opened the door for many, allowing them to participate in the life-changing opportunity to raise a puppy who will go on to become the eyes of a blind or visually impaired person."

No experience is necessary to raise a guide dog puppy, and much of the program has been altered to adhere to CDC health and safeety guidelines. Rather than in-person training classes, raisers now attend two rounds of online, Zoombased puppy training class to learn how to teach basic behaviors. They also have ongoing access to full "puppy tech support" via Guide Dogs of America's Canine Development staff. New volunteer raisers are also supported by volunteer area leaders and experienced raisers within their local communities, along with a host of additional webinars and learning opportunities.

Guide Dogs of America covers all medical expenses; puppy raisers pay for food, toys, and flea/tick medication. The puppy raiser's out-of-pocket expenses are tax-deductible. Raising a puppy can be the ideal project for people from all backgrounds: working professionals, families, empty-nesters, newly retired individuals, homeowners, apartment dwellers, homes with well-mannered resident pets, etc. Students especially benefit from the opportunity to raise, as the experience teaches valuable lessons about commuity service, animal care and training, and the disability community. In many cases, high school students obtain permission from school administrators to bring the puppy-

in-training to campus once it's old enough to behave appropriately in an academic environment.

"The most important trait of a successful puppy raiser is the desire to make a profound difference in someone's life, and an ability to invest the time necessary to properly train a dog," said Colman. "With the pandemic, we do want to make sure people anticipate successfully committing to the full raising assignment and aren't looking for a short-term project."

The puppy-raising assignment lasts for approximately 14 months. Puppies are matched with puppy raisers at 8 weeks old, and return to Guide Dogs of America for formal guide dog training at 16-18 months old. Formal guide dog training with the organization's professional trainers takes about four to six months. Once the dog completes formal training, its ready to be matched with a blind or visually impaired client. If a dog does not successfully complete guide dog training, it will be evaluated for placement in Guide Dogs of America's service dog program, Tender Loving Canines (TLC). The TLC program trains service dogs for military veterans, individuals on the autism spectrum, and facility dogs, which are matched to a professional handler to serve a vareity of vulnerable populations. If the dog is not suitable for any type of service dog work, the puppy raiser has the opportunity to adopt the dog.

Guide Dogs of America transforms lives through service dogs by training highly skilled guide dogs, PTSD dogs, autism dogs and facility dogs for clients throughout the United States and Canada. The organization graduates approximately 60 guide dog teams per year and an additional 20 service dog teams. Blind and visually impaired clients spend 21 days living on Guide Dogs of America's 7.5-acre campus learning how to work with and care for their highly skilled guide dogs. Service dog clients attend a 7-day, in-residence team-training. Dogs are matched to clients at no cost to them.
